The Clarke-Frederick-Warren 4-H and FFA Spring Beef Show will be held **Saturday, May 20, 2017** at the **Warren County Fairgrounds** with check-in beginning at 8:00 a.m. I strongly encourage any youth planning to show at the Clarke, Frederick, or Warren County Fair to participate in this show! It is a great opportunity for you and your animal to get acquainted and comfortable in a show atmosphere. A copy of the Rules and Regulations, Schedule, and Registration forms to register steers, commercial heifers, and purebred heifers are enclosed.

All entries must be postmarked or hand delivered by April 21, 2017 to your local extension office. A non-refundable entry fee of \$10.00 per head must accompany entry forms. **Checks should be made payable to Clarke-Frederick Beef Show.** Late fees will be \$15.00 per head and must be received or postmarked by May 5, 2017. *Any entries postmarked or delivered after the May 5<sup>th</sup> deadline will not be accepted in the show.*

**All beef entries must be accompanied by a health certificate, issued within the past 30 days and signed by an accredited veterinarian who states that the animals are free of infectious and contagious diseases.**

A completed, signed "Health History Report" for all exhibitors must also accompany entry forms and fees. Entry forms and fees should be mailed or hand delivered to the Frederick County Extension Office at 107 North Kent Street, Winchester, VA 22601.
